PERFORMER SPOTLIGHT



Xiaobo Li

Renowned Chinese erhu performer based in the U.S., and a contracted composer and musician for Chinese-language Hollywood films. In 2023, he received the Global Outstanding Chinese Lifetime Achievement Award in the U.S. He has contributed original scores to films such as *Very Lucky*, *Detective Chinatown*, *Little Door Gods*, *Shaolin: Legend of Treasure*, and TV dramas including *Phoenix Forever*, *My First Half of Life*, and *Loyal Yue Fei*.



Su She

Guzheng performer, educator, and contracted musician for Chinese-language Hollywood films. In 2024, she was invited to perform guzheng scores for Jackie Chan's new film *The Legend* and for *Detective Chinatown 1900*, directed by Wang Baoqiang and Chen Sicheng.



Hang Xue

A Chinese young baritone, he holds a Doctor of Musical Arts in Opera Performance from the United States. His professional affiliations include serving as a member of the Young Singers Academic Committee of the Ministry of Culture of China, a faculty member of the European Association for International Arts Education, and an honorary board member of the Global Musicians Association in New York. He also served as a vocal jury member for the 2025 6th APEX International Music Competition (New York Division).



Tong Xia

A young female soprano singer who has studied in the United States, she holds a doctorate and is a council member of the New York Opera Society. She is also a performer at the Bellevue Opera in Seattle, USA, and an external master's supervisor at the School of Art, Shandong University. In 2024, she was awarded the Best Chinese American of the Year. Her performance venues have covered many famous music halls and opera houses in the United States, such as the Lincoln Center in New York and Carnegie Hall.

Through our performances, we aim to preserve cultural heritage and inspire appreciation for this ancient instrument.



Omaha Hulusi Ensemble

The Omaha Hulusi Ensemble, founded in April 2025, brings together Chinese music lovers of all ages and experience levels across the Omaha Metro area. The ensemble specializes in multi-part arrangements of both traditional and modern Chinese melodies. The group seeks to share the beauty of the hulusi and Chinese music through community performances and cultural exchange.

Xi'an Hanshang Arts Training School is the province's first children's modeling and performance school with formal educational certification. Home to professional teams like Hanshang Kids Model and Hanshang Little Joy Arts Troupe, the school helps children gain confidence and joy through professional training, nurturing their poise, presence, and personal growth.

The Calamari Quintet

The Calamari Quintet, a student-founded ensemble from Millard North's Chamber Orchestra, is led by music director Debbie Martinez. Formed by Jackson Mu, Eunha Ok, Angela Qi, Ethan Sarkar, and Ceecee Soderlin, the group performs at celebrations, assisted living communities, and professional events. With multiple All-State musicians, they strive to inspire future students and leave a lasting legacy.



Established in 2013, Flamenco Omaha is a dance group formed by Dancer and Instructor Patricia Velazquez-Dunn. Our mission is to bring the rich and vibrant culture of Spain's most famous art form to the Midwest!



Blue Side Dance is a K-pop cover crew established in March 2025 by a group of friends who share a love for dance and K-pop. The team was created to introduce Nebraska audiences to the energy, storytelling, and artistry of K-pop through performance. Blue Side Dance continues to grow while celebrating the music and artists that inspire them.



Hashtag Harmony is a local Omaha Barbershop quartet which sings a cappella style harmony! They have competed regionally in the central states area finishing in the top 10! They have had singing performances for as many as 17 thousand people!



NEBRASKA CHINESE ASSOCIATION

The Nebraska Chinese Association (NCA), a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization, is dedicated to preserve the Chinese culture and heritage among Chinese community; to promote culture diversity to the local community; to inspire our members to learn and serve together; to build bridges between Chinese and American culture through educational programs, cultural events, and business collaboration; and to contribute to the prosperity and diversity of the community in the State of Nebraska.

NCA's goal is to help build a multicultural community in Omaha; to promote shared values of diversity, equity, and inclusion; to enhance the quality of life in Nebraska through the rich and colorful Chinese culture.

On April 23, 2016, Nebraska Chinese Association (NCA) Community Center opened its door at 8206 Blondo Street in Omaha. The NCA Center serves the Chinese community as a place to gather, celebrate Chinese culture through programs and events. At the Center, NCA offers a wide variety of educational and cultural programs to individuals and businesses, including Chinese language, summer camps, cooking, retirement planning, senior social, hometown group gathering, Chinese painting, folk dance, Ping-Pong club, Calligraphy and Arts, Tai-Chi, Chinese Chess group, college students social and so much more. All of our programs are open to the local community at large.

NCA hosts at least 3 major annual cultural festivals that brings joy and fun to the community. These festivals are the Chinese New Year Gala, the Dragon Boat Festival, and the One Community Cultural Festival. All these community events are open to the public to encourage community participation and cultural diffusion. All of our events are planned, organized, and sponsored by volunteers and local businesses at large.

NCA also provides local directory services to help new residents. Service directory includes information such as physicians, dental, real estate, and restaurants. NCA also manages a community Chat group/forum for discussions, recommendations, and suggestions which are related to Nebraska (Omaha) life. NCA also offers free seminars to the local Chinese community, such as Tax seminar, Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) seminar, and legal education seminar. NCA Timeline

2008

In May 2008, the Sichuan earthquake struck and resulted in nearly 70,000 deaths. After hearing the news about this disaster, many Chinese folks across the Greater Omaha area came together finding ways to help those affected. Volunteers hosted fundraisers to help raise money and awareness for this disaster. These events were widely reported by the local media. In December 2008, these volunteers joined together to form the Omaha Chinese Culture Association (OCCA).

2009

In 2009, OCCA successfully hosted the first annual Omaha Chinese New Year Gala at the Omaha Christ Community Church. That same year, OCCA opened the Chinese School and hosted the first Mid-Autumn Festival successfully.

2011

In 2011, OCCA invited officials from the Embassy of the People's Republic of China in the United States of America to come to Omaha. The embassy officials provided passport renewal service and assistance to Chinese citizens living in and around the Midwest. This year, OCCA also hosted the first Dragon Boat Festival event with a boat trip on the Missouri River.

2013

In 2013, OCCA accepted the invitation of then Nebraska Governor, Dave Heineman, and joined the ribbon-cutting ceremony for Nebraska's first China Trade Office.

2014

In 2014, OCCA Chinese School began offering language classes for children from non-Chinese-speaking families.

2015

In 2015, OCCA participated in Omaha Gives, Omaha's annual 24-hour charitable challenge.

2016

In 2016, OCCA changed its name to Nebraska Chinese Association (NCA) and opened the Nebraska Chinese Center in Omaha. That same year, NCA—along with the Nebraska Department of Economic Development, the Greater Omaha Chamber, and the American Chamber of Commerce—hosted the Omaha Investment Forum during the annual Berkshire Hathaway shareholder meeting weekend.

2017

In 2017, NCA became one of seven Overseas Chinese Service Centers in the United States. That same year, NCA launched the Guide for Chinese immigrants living in Nebraska. NCA Chinese School began offering free English classes for the new Chinese immigrants. NCA continued to host the Investment Forums during the annual Berkshire Hathaway meeting weekend.



NCA Timeline

2018

In the Spring of 2018, NCA invited Chinese Master Chefs as well as the “Culture of China, Festival of Spring” Nanjing performing arts group to visit Omaha to share our cultural experience with the local community. In June 2018, NCA became a certifying organization for the President’s Volunteer Service Award (PVSA).

2019

In 2019, NCA organized and hosted the first of its kind cultural event, One Community Cultural Festival, in Omaha to celebrate and share the diverse cultures of this community. The event attracted over 30 cultural performing groups and presented 15 different countries. In addition, NCA organized volunteers, including youth volunteers to help with the March 2019 Nebraska Flood clean up events and raised about \$5,000 to help the flood victims in Nebraska and Iowa.

2020

In 2020, Governor Pete Ricketts proclaimed January 25, 2020 as “Chinese Lunar New Year Day”. During the COVID-19 pandemic, NCA donated more than 35,000 personal protective equipment (PPE) to help protect medical workers and first responders.

2021

In 2021, NCA donated necessary PPEs to local businesses, and worked with local Health Departments to promote the COVID-19 vaccination among the Chinese community in Nebraska. NCA also continued to work with local and out-of-state non-profit organizations to promote diversity awareness.

2022


In 2022, NCA received recognition from the Nebraska Department of Education (NDE) World Language Education for supporting the Seal of Biliteracy. In addition, NCA hosted the second annual One Community Cultural Festival at the Stinson Park in Omaha. Thousands of the community members came to enjoy the cultural performance and culinary delights around the world.

2023

In 2023, NCA resumed post-pandemic activities, including in-person classes at the NCA Chinese school and its first Lunar New Year Gala since COVID-19. In September, NCA partnered with the RiverFront and the Omaha Symphony for the first time to co-host the third One Community Cultural Festival (OCCF), featuring performances from over 20 local groups to celebrate cultural diversity.

2024

In 2024, NCA elected a new board and leadership team and renovated its center to better support community activities. Cultural outreach programs fully resumed, with volunteers dedicating over 1,000 hours to performances and events at senior centers, schools, companies, and even out-of-state in Des Moines and Iowa City. Additionally, NCA continued its partnership with the RiverFront and the Omaha Symphony to co-host the fourth One Community Cultural Festival (OCCF).




NCA Timeline



2025

In 2025, NCA brought Chinese culture to communities across Nebraska. We presented traditional music and dance at cultural festivals in Lincoln, Norfolk, and Grand Island, allowing broader audiences to experience and appreciate Chinese heritage.

NCA also hosted a vibrant Dragon Boat Festival celebration to engage children in learning about Chinese traditions and once again partnered with The RiverFront to successfully present the 5th Annual One Community Cultural Festival (OCCF).





NCA CHINESE SCHOOL

NCA 中文学校简介



NCA Chinese School (formerly the Omaha Chinese Culture Association Chinese School) was founded in 2008. We welcome learners of all ages and backgrounds.

We offer a comprehensive program ranging from Kindergarten through AP Chinese. For non-heritage learners, we also provide Easy Chinese courses for children and adults, including beginner and intermediate levels. No prior knowledge of Chinese is required.

In addition to Chinese instruction, we offer a variety of classes, including dance, painting, arts and crafts, table tennis, and Tai-chi. We also provide English classes for adults with little or no English proficiency.

Classes are held once a week on Saturdays and are grouped according to students' proficiency levels. Our experienced teachers create an engaging and supportive learning environment.
